

# DRESS CODE & HANDS OFF POLICY 0910

## ***DRESS CODE***

### **Expectations**

Students should dress sensibly in clothing that is appropriate to the school or work setting. The dress code includes the following but is not limited to these guidelines:

- no bandanas may be worn or displayed in any way
- no bare feet
- no bare midriffs (bellybuttons)
- no halter tops
- no spaghetti straps
- no exposed underwear or bras
- no very tight or revealing clothing
- no short shorts or short skirts: Hemlines will be between just above the knee and below the fingertips when arms are placed to the side of the body with relaxed fingertips.
- no articles of clothing bearing vulgar, discriminatory or derogatory messages or images (For example FCUK - French Connection United Kingdom)
- no articles of clothing bearing drug or alcohol related messages or images
- at this school hats are not to be worn inside the school building
- Shirts and tops must have a neckline to sufficiently cover the entire chest area (No Cleavage)
- Pants may not be worn below the waist or be so long that they drag on the floor

### **Consequence**

If clothing is inappropriate, the student will be required to change into something which is appropriate. This may involve being sent home.
